

WALL DARTS

(INDIVIDUAL EVENT) OPEN

ELIGIBILITY

Participants do not have to qualify through regional play-offs. Entries must be sent directly to the Games office. Entry forms may be obtained from the office or website.

EVENT CLASSIFICATION

- MEN: 55+ & 70+
- WOMEN: 55+ & 70+

MINIMUM # OF ENTRIES REQUIRED: 3 Individuals/Age Category to host that age category

RULES & REGULATIONS

Rules established by the Manitoba Dart Association will apply, with the following amendments:

1. Players will determine order of play by preliminary throw, the dart nearest the bull will go first.
2. Players do not have to double in, but must double out, including the centre bull.
3. Darts must be thrown from behind the toe line 7' 9.5"/2.4m. The board is at a height of 5 feet 8 inches from its centre point to the floor.
4. Scores will be deducted from a starting total of 301.
5. The final game will be best 2 out of 3, throws will be deducted from 501.
6. If time is running short it will be the head judges decision only to have any players who are taking an excess of time to double out, to single out instead.
7. If a player shows up more than 5 minutes late for the tournament start and are scheduled to play they will default that first game.
8. If a player defaults a game during tournament play they will be disqualified from the tournament.

OFFICIALS

There will be a head judge identified at the start of the tournament. Scorekeepers will be provided for each game. Persons not playing may be asked to assist with score keeping duties.

EQUIPMENT

Players must bring their own darts.

TOURNAMENT DRAW

A round robin or two division round robin will be played, depending on the number of entries. Two points will be awarded for a win and zero for a loss.

TWO DIVISION ROUND ROBIN:

Play-off Elimination Draw:

First in Pool A vs. second in Pool B

First in Pool B vs. second in Pool A

The winners from this will go on to play a game to determine first and second place.

The losing teams will play a game to determine third place.

SINGLE DIVISION ROUND ROBIN: (10 players or less)

The top three players will play-off (round robin) to determine first, second, and third place.

TIE BREAKING SYSTEM

1. **DIVISION STANDINGS:** In the event two players are tied in division standings, the winner of the previous meeting will advance. If more than two players are tied within a division with only a portion advancing to playoffs, there will be one game of 301 points with all players tied playing concurrently on the same board. The first player to finish will be awarded the first available playoff position. Play is continued until all available playoff positions are filled.
