Reporting to the Executive Director the Manitoba 55+ Games Coordinator will be responsible for effectively managing the schedule, cost and overall implementation of the largest multi-sport event held for older adults in Manitoba. We are seeking a candidate who is highly organized, creative, enthusiastic, personable, and ready to hit the ground running to ensure continued success with the 2024 Games. This is a critical role requiring a combination of project management, event management and strong interpersonal skills to be successful. AAIM is offering a six-month contract position to commence on February 12, 2024, with the possibility of becoming a permanent position.

The Games Coordinator, working closely with the Executive Director and host community committees, will manage all aspects of the planning and delivery of the in-person and virtual Games including:

- Monitoring the Games deliverables and risks and communicating with the AAIM Executive Director to ensure strong fiscal management and timely and effective problem solving.
- Collaborating with the Executive Director to develop and fulfill an effective communications and social media strategy to increase brand awareness and maintain brand integrity.
- Working with sport governing bodies and associations to ensure technical requirements are followed.
- Coordinating the Games promotions, campaigns, and events.

## To succeed in this role, you will:

- Have a proven track record of successfully executing events and the ability to prioritize and manage multiple deliverables on time and within budget.
- Be resourceful, work independently, think critically, and have problem solving skills with the ability to recognize and adapt to changing situations.
- Be a strong team-oriented leader with proven ability to work with multiple stakeholders, community volunteers, related committees, and decision makers to develop and maintain collaborative networks.
- Have experience working with older adults in the community.
- Have sporting event management experience including use of applicable software.
- Be involved in and have knowledge of the non-profit sector.

- A post-secondary degree in Kinesiology, Recreation Management, or a related field.
- A minimum of 3 years project or event management experience.
- Strong social media skills including Facebook and Instagram, and Microsoft Office skills including Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
